ARSENIC REMEDIATION PROJECT UPDATE

Despite the heavy snow and cold weather, we continue to make progress on the Proposition 84 Arsenic Remediation Project. As I hope everyone is aware, all of the wells that exceeded the arsenic standards were removed from service in 2018 along with the well that exceeded the State standards for antimony and fluoride. All water is now produced from the Montclaire well which meets all primary drinking water standards although it does exceed the secondary standards for iron and manganese.

The iron and manganese treatment plant has been built and a predelivery inspection has been performed by our engineer and we are now waiting for delivery and installation. Once installed, tested and permitted, the treatment plant will remove iron and manganese to levels below the State standards.



Also, District staff has been very busy installing the needed electrical and data lines and equipment for the SCADA (Supervisory Control And Data Acquisition) system that will provide us with near real-time status information on water storage levels along with well and treatment plant operational status.

Once complete, our water will meet all State water quality standards!
